

# My Roles

**Definition:** A role a security setting which allows a user see and use different parts on the eIRB system.

If you have more than one role in the system you can jump between role specific home pages. The most common occurrence from this is a committee member that is also a Principal Investigator. Each Role in the system has a different home page which will contain a different set of actions (buttons). Example: The only place a New Study application can be started is on the home page of a user that has the Role Principle Investigator or Study Coordinator.






